ONTARIO-BRED WELSH COMES OUT ON TOP AT THE KYM K. SMITH / USHJA YOUNG HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIPS

At the 2022 Kym K. Smith / USHJA Young Hunter Pony Championships, a young Ontario-bred Welsh, Reidell Pumpkin Spice (registered as Reidell Raysun), was awarded the highly coveted title of Overall Grand Champion. Reidell Pumpkin Spice is a 2016 Half Welsh gelding by Rollingwoods Raisin Ruckus and out of Northwind Face the Nation. He was bred by Rose Reid of Reidell Farms in Ashburn, Ontario, and is now owned by Kristin Wells and trained by Carol Eichner. At the Kym K. Smith / USHJA Young Hunter Pony Championships, he was expertly piloted by Eddyn Molden to win the 6 & 7 Y/O 2'3" and 6 & 7 Y/O 2'6" divisions. The Making of a Legend

Born May 2020, at the beginning of a world-wide pandemic, was an inspirational colt. Sired by the extremely successful Welsh Pony sire, "Telynau Royal Anthem", and out of a phenomenal producer, "Mapleside Oops", this colt had a striking presence and we knew he could be a serious contender in the show ring. With the limitations of travel and most horse shows cancelled during the 2020 and 2021 season, we anticipated the return of in-hand shows in order to showcase this colt.

We were proud to present "Annings Legend" at the iconic 126th Devon Horse Show. The historic venue creates many nostalgic sentiments. It is the oldest and largest multi-breed horse show, with a midway featuring a large Ferris wheel. This being his first horse show, it was highly intimidating for the two-year-old stud colt and our team. Our expectations had to be managed as we rolled into the quaint shed rows with large blue grand stands.

We were very fortunate to have had a great mentor in Prue Richardson, with whom we had shared many previous trips to Devon. Prue's guidance had prepared our team for the various challenges that we faced in our attempts at a successful horse show.

We were able to ship in on Wednesday and the young ponies show first-thing Thursday morning, so there isn't much time to prepare them. The rings are small and very busy with seasoned show horses preparing for their own week of competition. Our Canadian team of 9 ponies kept us exceptionally busy as we helped to adapt them to the horse show environment.

Three experienced and patient braiders arrived at midnight to begin braiding the young ponies. It was key that our team be there to help throughout the night, as most of the young ones have never been braided before. It is always a miraculous sight to see the show rings fill to the brim with show horses preparing in the early hours of the morning under large post lights.





The Pony Hunter Foal class started at 7:30am. With an entry or two of our own in each of the classes, we reached out to a well-known handler, Charlie Brown, for his assistance on show day. We had never met Mr. Charlie Brown and exchanged less than a handful of text messages prior to the moment he walked the colt into the show ring. Rumour had it he was the one for the job.

Mr. Brown presented "Annings Legend" with grace and patience. The class of 14 two-year-old colts and geldings was perhaps one of the most impressive groups of young ponies I have had the pleasure of standing amongst. The moment that happened next has been but a dream for over 15 years. Annings Legend was announced as placing first in the Hunter Pony Two-Year-Old Colts & Geldings. We were immensely proud, as this is the first time a homebred of ours has won its class at Devon.

The team swiftly took the colt back into his stall and patiently stood with him as we awaited his return to the ring. After getting a quick touch up, Annings Legend returned to the ring to compete with all the successful

Board of Directors Meeting Minutes May 19th, 2022 @ 7:30pm

1. Called to Order / Acceptance of Past Minutes

Rose called the meeting to order at 7:41pm

Motion to accept the April 7th minutes.

Maisie / Diane

2. Business Conducted through Facebook Group Since the Last Meeting

- a. Board agreed to cancel the clinic part of the April 30th schooling day as we did not have much response from members.
- b. Board agreed to revise the arrival time for the Sport Pony judges at the Classic and the All Welsh to 10:30am.

3. All Welsh / Classic

- a. **Sport Pony** – The wrong date for the Classic was posted again on the Sport Pony Show Schedule. Darlene has been contacted to correct it.
- b. **Trophies** – Maisie has a list of the 2019 recipients. Directors will take inventory of what they have and then we will begin contacting the rest of the recipients.

We will continue to hand out the trophies the day of the show as it is not feasible to collect and store them all. Members will be reminded that they need to bring them to the show or make arrangements to hand them in prior to the show.

- c. **Classic Prize List** – Sponsorship just needs to be added. Hope is that it can be released next week.
- d. **Breeder's Challenge Class** – entries in this class were low last year and we do not currently have a sponsor. We will not run it this year. Rose will contact Amanda Mills who was donating neck sashes to inform her.
- e. **Sponsors** – Corina will post a last call for sponsors to be included in the prize lists. Corina will be reaching out to past sponsors this week to see if they would like to sponsor again this year.
- f. **Judge's Contracts** – contracts have been received back from Kylie and Hilary. Corina sent reminders to Robbie and Shannon today.

4. Champion of Champions

- a. Out of Province Qualifiers – will have to get a report from Medea on whether Manitoba or NEWPA has responded. We will need this information ASAP as the deadline for the Royal has already passed.
- b. The Board agreed to allow the BC Virtual Show to be a qualifier this year to give ponies out West a chance to qualify since Wild Rose is not running.

5. Schooling Days / Clinics

- a. April 30th Schooling Day - Janet reported that the day went well. They had about 8 ponies in attendance.
- b. Request for a Clinic – Briarwood Farms requested to have someone come out to do an in hand clinic for their students like in 2019. The board decided that this is most easily arranged between the farm and a judge/clinician directly. Corina will reply back with the list of National judges as suggestions for individuals to contact.

6. Treasurer's Report

Banking – Rose has left multiple messages for the Sutton Scotiabank and has not had any of her calls answered. Rose and Corina drove up there today to try to get some answers and were told that the Small Business/Branch Manager was the one they needed to speak to but she was not in that day. They were able to order cheques which will be mailed to Corina. Medea will have to make an appointment at the bank with the Manager and Corina and Rose will meet her there.

Motion to pay the outstanding Ribbon Works invoice.

Motion to reimburse Maisie for the Zoom subscription.

Janet/Corina All in Favour CARRIED

Rose will ask Jess to sign a few more checks so that these items can be paid.

7. Newsletter

Spring WelshBeat deadline will be end of May. Corina will post it to the Facebook page.

8. Website

- a. Website Domain – www.wpcao.com is not available but www.wpcao.ca is. Pricing changes day to day but typically is \$10-15 a year. Payment must be done by Paypal or credit card which we currently don't have.

Motion to purchase the www.wpcao.ca domain for a two-year plan and to reimburse Corina for the cost.

Janet/Maisie All in Favour CARRIED

- b. Wix Plan – we will start with the Combo plan (\$15/month) for now and upgrade to Premium (\$20/month) if we need it. We will go with the two-year plan for cost savings. Corina will figure out what payment options there are.

1. Called to Order / Acceptance of Past Minutes

Rose called the meeting to order at 7:45pm

Motion: To accept the May 19th meeting minutes

Corina / Maisie All in Favour CARRIED

2. Business Conducted through Facebook Group Since the Last Meeting

a. Rose and Corina counted and reported ribbon numbers for the Classic. All accounted for.

3. Correspondence

- a. Member expressed that they were unhappy with how much the association has moved towards Facebook and felt this was unfair for those who prefer email. Member was directed to our new website and reminded of the quarterly WelshBeat.
- b. Member expressed offence to the Facebook post reminding everyone that there is a \$10 admin fee for any memberships submitted after May 31st, as they felt this should be a private matter between each member and the board. Member was assured that the post was not directed to anyone in particular and that the board was simply being proactive.

4. All Welsh / Classic

- a. Sponsorship Update
 - i. All classes except 2 Sport Pony have sponsors. Corina is collecting and labeling prizes and will bring to the Classic.
 - ii. Still a number of classes available to be sponsored at the All Welsh.
- b. Trophies
 - i. All 3 trophies for the Classic are accounted for (Janet – Sec. A, Diane – Sec. B & Supreme)
 - ii. Corina will post a request to members to return any All Welsh trophies. A number of them are already in the board's possession.
- c. Volunteers – Classic
 - i. Request to members will be put out on Facebook
 - ii. Roles needing to be filled – ring steward, in gate, prize/ribbon coordinator
 - iii. Charis Casey has volunteered to ring steward for the performance classes. Rose will inquire with Pete if he is available to ring steward the in-hand classes.
 - iv. Rose to inquire with Russel Morton if he is available to ingate
- d. Corina will update the Classic prize list with new sponsors and send to Maisie to have ready for the show.
- e. All Welsh prize list is almost ready but we will hold off releasing it until after the Classic as to not confuse people.

5. Champion of Champions

- a. Qualifying Ribbons – Rose has all the qualifying ribbons from Kelly. She will bring them to the Classic to give to Medea to work out getting them to all the qualifying shows.
- b. Letter/Form for Qualifying Ponies – a new form/letter will need to be created to send out with the qualifying ribbons to gather pony/owner's information as well as their confirmation that they will be attending the RAWF
- c. Out of Province Qualifiers Update
 - i. Some confusion with the BC Virtual Show about the qualifier – they have extended their deadline and are promoting it as a qualifier now
 - ii. NEWPA runs next week and doesn't appear to have the qualifier listed in their prize book. Not sure if they declined or if there was a miscommunication.
 - iii. Manitoba Show – Medea to provide update on whether they accepted
- d. We need conformation from Pete of the prize money listed in the RAWF prize book so that we can promote it.

6. Treasurer's Report

- a. Banking Update – Medea to provide an update on setting up the appointment at the Sutton Bank ASAP.
- b. Corina is now being mailed the monthly statements. As of May 31st, we stood at \$10,419.17 in our account.
- c. Since we cannot directly pull funds from the account, a cheque for the total amount of prize money for the Classic will be sent to Maisie who will withdraw the funds. Janet and Maisie will prepare all the prize money in labelled envelopes to bring to the Classic. Corina to calculate total prize money next week so cheque can be sent.

Motion: To send Maisie a cheque for the total amount of prize money being given out at the Welsh Summer Classic.

- a. The WPCSC has informed us that we will not need to put forth a recommendation for Royal Rep. They have only allowed us to do this in the past as a courtesy. The WPCSC puts forward a candidate to the Royal and the Royal makes the ultimate decision.
