Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

March 10th, 2022 @ 7:30pm

Present: Medea, Janet, Maisie, Pete, Rose, Corina, Diane, Jenna (joined at 8:25pm - not present for motions)

Recorder: Corina

1. Called to Order / Acceptance of Past Minutes

Rose called the meeting to order at 7:35pm.

Janet made a motion to accept the February 10th Minutes. Pete seconded. All in favour. Carried.

2. Business Conducted through Facebook Group Since the Last Meeting

- a. Erin Fairgrounds confirmed at same price as last year. Bathrooms will be available pending Covid guidelines. Both the North and South Rings are available.
- b. Sutton Prize List - revisions sent to Matt asking to have the driving classes split as A/B To Drive and C/D To Drive as well as adding Half Welsh to the driving.

3. All Welsh / Classic

- a. Judges (Classic) - Robbie Donaldson (Welsh) and Shannon Smith (Sport Pony) are confirmed.
- b. Location (Classic) - contract and payment have been sent to Erin Fairgrounds for July 23rd. Diane will contact Erin to confirm that hydro is available at the South Ring - if so, this would be our ring preference.

Rose has confirmed our dates with Darlene for Sport Pony.

c. Prize List Changes

Open/ Adult Walk/Trot class - not sure if we would have the numbers to support this class. Those who are not comfortable cantering are welcome to enter the W/T/C class and not canter.

Combining Sec. A & Sec. B to Drive - we have not had the entries the last number of years to warrant them being split.

Pete made a motion to combine the Sec. A & B driving classes. Corina seconded. All in favour. Carried.

We will move the Novice driving class to before Half Welsh so that the green ponies all have a chance to see the ring before their other classes.

We will add a note in the prize list at the beginning of the performance classes reminding

exhibitors that classes with low entries may be judged in the ring at the same time but placed separately.

Ages for Leadline/W-T classes - our LL Walk Only class has an age requirement of 4-7 but our LL W/T class and W/T classes are 12 & Under, allowing riders under 4 to show in those classes but not the W only. Most of the fairs seem to have the Walk Only age as 7 & Under - this can make High Point difficult.

Pete made a motion to leave the ages the same for this year. Maisie seconded. All in favour. Carried. We will revisit this early next year so that we can make a decision before fair prize lists are confirmed.

Breeder's Challenge U/S - Rose will reach out to last years sponsors to see if they would like this class run again.

d. **Sponsorship**

We will offer line class sponsorship for \$50 each. Champion classes will be \$100. Payouts will be standard across all classes. Prizes will be used for performance classes. Corina will create another GoogleSheets to keep it all organized.

4. **Champion of Champions**

- a. Out of Province Qualifiers - Medea still to contact NEWPA, Wild Rose, Quebec and Manitoba. Quebec is planning to run a show. Wild Rose is up in the air.
- b. ChC Blurb for Fairs - Sutton needs their ChC instructions rewritten as they are outdated. Corina will put something together tonight and send it off as their deadline is tomorrow.

5. **Schooling Days / Clinics**

The March 19th date did not work for Ten Sixty. Janet will work on a new date for early April.

We have not heard back from any of the west-end facilities we inquired with about hosting.

6. **Treasurer's Report**

- a. Banking Update - Medea to go into the bank in Sutton to try to deposit membership cheques and find out what is needed to change over directors. We are almost out of cheques so needs to be worked out ASAP.
- b. Insurance - Rose mailed the cheque. Medea was able to get the information on the forms changed from Jess's to her name. She will fill them out and send them in.

7. **Newsletter / Directories**

Directories nearly done - waiting on the last couple ads. Newsletter will be out by end of month.

8. Website

Corina received the USB from Jess with all the old files. She will start going through them for website content once the directories and newsletters are out.

9. Other Business

- a. Lindsay Fair Prize List – Maisie has a meeting with the fair board later this month and will be asking to add Half Welsh to the driving. Will also see about adding back the W/T/C equitation classes. Have to be careful about adding too many classes at once as there has been push back in the past. She will also inquire about combining low entry classes but having prize money still paid out individually.
- b. Caledon & Markham Fair Organizers – both fairs reached out to the board asking for someone to run their shows. Corina will put out a request on Facebook. Janet and Jenna to reach out to a couple people.
- c. Arthur Fair – will no longer be running a Welsh show

1. Called to Order / Acceptance of Past Minutes

Rose called the meeting to order at 7:36pm.

Maisie made a motion to accept the March 10th meeting minutes. Jenna seconded. All in favour. Carried.

2. Business Conducted through Facebook Group Since the Last Meeting

Board approved the digital membership card Medea created.

3. All Welsh / Classic

- a. Judges Contracts – Corina will send out judges contracts this month.

Janet made a motion that we pay \$350 to the Welsh judges and \$150 to the Sport Pony judges at the All Welsh and Classic. Maisie seconded. All in favour. Carried.

- b. Sponsorship – sponsorship request has been put out on Facebook and the newsletter. Google Docs has been created like last year to track sponsorships. Corina has been in contact with Michelle Drake (member) who volunteered to help with sponsorship.
 - c. Sport Pony Fee – clarification was made that the Sport Pony fee at the All Welsh and Classic only allows the exhibitor to enter the Sport Pony classes. If they would like to enter any Welsh classes, they must buy a WPCAO membership. We will ensure that this is clearly stated in our prize lists.
- 4. Champion of Champions**
- a. Out of Province Qualifiers – Quebec has confirmed they will hold a qualifier. Medea still to reach out to Wild Rose, NEWPA, and Manitoba.
 - b. Need to confirm if Pete has offered Markham the floating qualifier and if they have accepted it.
- 5. Schooling Days / Clinics**
- a. Next schooling day is tentatively April 30th – Janet to confirm next week with Ten Sixty. We will have use of the large outdoor if weather permits – indoor arena as a backup option.
 - b. Will plan for an in-hand mini clinic at the beginning of the next schooling day. If possible, we will have a few instructors to allow for small groups. Jenna Ponzo, McKeens, and Jeff Kohler were suggested.
- 6. Treasurer's Report**
- a. Banking – Medea was able to deposit the membership cheques and get the name of the manager that should be able to help us sort out the account. She will pass her information onto Rose to sort out our next steps and what is the best protocol for changing of officers moving forward.
 - b. Cheques need to be ordered ASAP. In the past, two officers were needed but Rose will ask our new contact person if she is able to get them on her own.
- 7. Newsletter**
- a. Winter issue was sent out and Spring issue is planned for early June.
- 8. Website**
- a. Corina is nearly done with website creation – link to the site was sent to directors to review. Still need to adjust for phone viewing. Still looking for the following content:
 - i. List of Champion of Champion Winners pre 2010 – Corina will see if Pete has this. If not, will contact Christine Reupke.
 - ii. About/History of the WPCAO – Pete may have some information. Mary Cork and Shirly Cane were also suggested.

- b. Domain - www.wpcao.ca was proposed. It was suggested the .com may be better. Corina will look into if this is available. Payment for the domain as well as the Wix subscription must be paid by credit card or PayPal. We currently do not have a credit card so we will need to get one once we have our banking sorted out.

9. Other Business

- a. WPCAO Scholarship - we need to determine if we will be offering this again and if it need to be revised, as we are not sure it is working as intended. Current application sent to directors to review before next meeting.
- b. Lindsay Fair - Maisie reported that at the Lindsay Fair meeting concerns of sponsorship vs payout were brought up. She was able to put together much more accurate numbers than what the fair provided. It was proposed that the W/T/C Equitation classes be added back as well.
- c. Markham Fair - some confusion about who will be organizing Markham Fair. Rose will contact Holly Purcell to clear up what they are asking for.
- d. Fenlon Fair - Maisie was contacted by the fair, as they are looking to add more horse/pony shows. Maisie proposed they either run performance classes only or a full slate of classes.

10. Future Meeting Dates

May 5th, June 2nd, July 7th, July 28th, August 11th, September 8th, October 6th, November 3rd, November 24th

Corina will not be able to attend the next meeting. Meeting will be recorded and sent to Corina to do up the minutes.
