Royal Agricultural Winter Fair Announcement



Due to our ongoing concern regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, the excitement of The Royal will have to wait for another year. The Royal's Board of Directors today made the heart-wrenching but unanimous decision to cancel the 2020 Royal Agricultural Winter Fair, originally scheduled for November 6th to 15th at Exhibition Place, Toronto. This treasured annual tradition will return better than ever in 2021.

"Over the past several months, we've all experienced an unprecedented disruption to our daily lives and are redefining how we live, work and play. Ultimately, our decision is grounded in our commitment to help ensure the health and well-being of our community at large," stated Charlie Johnstone, Chief Executive Officer at The Royal. "Our primary responsibility remains rooted in serving our community and protecting the integrity and welfare of all. We understand and appreciate the time, effort and financial commitment required to compete and exhibit at The Royal and did not make this decision without very careful consideration."

The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair is the largest combined indoor agricultural fair and international equestrian competition in the world. Each fall, The Royal brings together hundreds of competitors, thousands of animals and hundreds of thousands of guests to celebrate the best in agriculture, local food, and equestrian competition. During its storied history, The Royal has been cancelled on only one other occasion, during World War II. At that time, the stalls within the historic Royal Horse Palace were transformed into Army Barracks to house soldiers preparing to be deployed to join our Canadian and Allied troops fighting in Europe. Today, The Royal once again stands in support of its community, first and foremost.

"During these uncertain times, we're heartened by the resilience of farmers, the ingenuity of entrepreneurs, and the abundance of care shown towards family, friends and animals," concluded Johnstone. "As we lead up to our 100th Anniversary celebrations in 2022, we take comfort knowing that the 2021 Royal Agricultural Winter Fair will be, as always, an outstanding experience for all those who compete, exhibit and attend."

In addition to The Royal's Agricultural Food Competitions, which will still take place in 2020, virtual programming designed to engage, educate and motivate is currently being explored for this Fall. More details regarding this exciting initiative will be released soon. In the meantime, all Canadians are encouraged to continue supporting Canadian farmers, producers and local retailers.

Together we will get through this, and "Bring the Country to the City" next November 5th to 14th, 2021.

Royal Agricultural Winter Fair Stallion Showcase

We are keenly aware of the important role that winning a class at The Royal Horse Show plays in the promotion of your breeding stallions. As this has been a difficult year for many of you, The Royal will be offering Canadian Breeders, with horses at stud in Canada, the opportunity to be featured in our online Stallion Showcase.

The Stallion Showcase will be an online publication in conjunction with our "Virtual Royal" presentation in November.

This is being offered free of charge to Canadian breeders only. All Stallions submitted must be owned or leased by Canadian citizens and be standing at stud in Canada.

Submission Deadline: September 28, 2020

All entries in the catalogue must supply the following:

- Full name of horse as registered and competition name if different from registered name.
 - Sire & Dam of the Stallion.
 - Height of horse/pony Stallion.
 - Stallion Registration number and DOB.
 - Owner and Breeder.
 - Career Highlights (may also include successful offspring winnings/achievements).
 - A scanned copy of registration papers where applicable. (Sportpony entries may or may not be registered and TB entries may only have a tattoo or TIP number, both/either of which are acceptable.)
 - A high-quality photo in PNG or JPEG for RAWF's use online. Landscape orientation required. Both action and conformation shots are acceptable based on breed norms and breeder's preference.
- Submissions may be denied if photos are not acceptable.

ENTRY deadline: Saturday, September 5th, 2020

· Entry fee \$30.00 per exhibitor/owner. This entry fee pays for the judge, the flat ribbons and the mailing of the ribbons. All excess funds will be submitted to Arthur Agricultural Society to ensure that we will have a Welsh and Open Pony Show in future years.

· *There is no restriction to location of owner and/or pony – this virtual show is open to the world.*

· Welsh and Half Welsh entries MUST be registered with their respective registries and provide registration numbers. Exception: foals may be pending but must be eligible for registration.

· Open Pony entries MUST be PONIES, 14.2hh and under. Grade or registered. Please note breed and if registered provide registration number and registry.

· Youth exhibitors under 18 years of age

· Youths may NOT show stallions

· **All Exhibitors** must wear properly fastened ASTM approved protective headgear while mounted or in driven vehicles.

· Show rules of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Canada apply to all Welsh and Half-Welsh classes

· Open Pony rules – follow Pony Breeders of Ontario guidelines (www.PonyBreedersOfOntario.weebly.com)

· Remember we are relying on your HONESTY to make this work. Besides, someone, somewhere will rat you out.

· Static photos NO VIDEO, no 3-D images. All images are not to be retouched, cropping only is allowed.

· All classes will be placed to 5th place but flat ribbons will only be awarded to the top 3 placings. No champion awards – you get the recognition!

· Photos are to be taken in 2020, NO photos taken at shows or by a paid professional

· *Classes may be combined or further split dependent on entries. Management reserves the right to limit entries*

· No cross entry of pony/rider combination between leadline or walk-trot and any class with a canter option. A leadline entry may enter their respective walk-trot class.

- ALL entries must have entry fee received either via e-transfer or PayPal before being deemed completed. Monies are to be sent to dimac99@hotmail.com, in Canadian funds.
- ALL ENTRIES (i.e. each pony) must include the following information:
 - o Pony's Name (registered name)
 - o Rider's name in each photo (please add age for junior exhibitors)
 - o Breed, Section (if applicable), Registration Number, Age and Gender (Mare, Stallion or Gelding)
 - o Sire (where known)
 - o Dam (where known)
 - o Owner's name, full mailing address and email
 - o Classes entered
 - o Photo credit (who took the photo)
 - o Statement agreeing to allow Arthur Fair Virtual Pony Show to display all photo entries publicly
 - o Date will be taken as the day the entry (photos submitted, information above and the payment of entry fee)
- Entries are to be emailed to dimac99@hotmail.com Please remember to make sure your entries have been sent correctly, as there are file size limits on your internet server and the receiving internet servers, check your Junk Mail folders for returned emails. Show host will not go to your website or Facebook page or... and pick up images. It is your responsibility to submit them. Zip files and Drop Box are fine. Any other method of entry submission will not be accepted.
- Be patient for a response on accepted entries – we work, have ponies and other things to do in life – this is a VOLUNTEER activity.

General Rules

1. One photo per horse/rider combination in each class. i.e. you cannot submit 2 photos of the same horse and rider in a single class
2. Unlimited entries per exhibitor per class – HOWEVER, if you have 20 Section Bs and 15 riders, we don't want to see every combination. CHOOSE YOUR BEST! Remember someone has to judge these classes.
3. We require your honesty. Exhibitors need to follow NORMAL show rules. No illegal tack or gadgets. Our organizing committee requires helmets for all riders and drivers, any entry not conforming to this rule will be eliminated.
4. We have asked for NO show photos and NO paid professional photos to level the playing field for ALL entrants. Use 2020 photos please.
5. Photos are to be landscape, either direction. Conformation photos are not to have humans in the photo. Performance photos are also to be landscape. In Leadline, please have the handler not blocking the judge's view of pony and rider.
6. Exhibitors and ponies are to be clad as if they ARE at a show. Ponies in halter/conformation classes need to be wearing halters or bridles and either have evidence of being held or tied. PLEASE do not tie your pony by the reins!
7. In order to keep the judging fair and uninfluenced, they will be loaded to the Facebook page by a single individual (Diana Macdonald). Only the photos and the entry number will be available to the judge. The page will be PRIVATE to the host organizer and judge only until all judging is complete. This way there will be no likes, loves or comments to potentially influence the judge. Once the judging is complete, the page will be made PUBLIC for all to see. All details submitted in the entry will be added to each photo as well as the placings. This will allow for exposure of breeding and ponies!
8. Depending on number of entries as to whether Welsh will be eligible to cross enter into Open Pony, as we normally do in the real show. Please submit your entries as if they will be permitted to cross enter.
9. Judge's decision is FINAL

Rules for Breed Show Line Classes & Showmanship Classes

1. **Four photos and one video** are required for each entry (unless otherwise specified).
2. The video is to be **no longer than 2 minutes** and must be **one continuous video**. Do not edit multiple videos together.
3. Videos and pictures are not to be edited in any way. Entries that do not adhere to the specifications for videos and images will be disqualified.
4. The photos must show the animal's front, rear, and both sides to accurately judge conformation. The animal must be completely in view, centered, and occupy the majority of the frame of view. Show person does not need to be in the photo. The animal must be shown on clean, flat ground, and feet must be clearly visible (no straw, bedding, rough terrain, or long vegetation).

LIGHT HORSE MEDIA SUBMISSION RULES

1. All video must be muted (no sound).
2. Videos and photos may not include any farm names, farm signs, or advertising.
3. Video quality must be 720p or higher (no 4K).
4. Animals must be suitably clean and tidy. Manes and tails must be clean and tidy. Animals may be clipped (where appropriate) but it is not mandatory. Braiding is not required.
5. Photos and videos may be re-used for multiple classes where applicable.
6. Photos and video will be available on our website and on social media. Ensure your media submissions portray a positive image of breed standards, appropriately attired handlers, and healthy animals.
7. Video and photos must be taken between the dates of August 1st to September 18, 2020.
8. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to upload the entry video(s) and photo(s) in the correct format within the acceptable time frame. Judging may begin **IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE ENTRY DEADLINE**.
9. The Society reserves the right to disqualify any entries that do not appear to satisfy standard health requirements acceptable for in-person competition. Animals that display signs of distress, ill health, or are not an acceptable representation of a healthy animal, based on species specific criteria, will be disqualified. All material from the Virtual LEX is available for the public to view and all entries must represent high standards of animal care.

Highlights from the WPCS Judging & Showing Handbook

BREED DESCRIPTION

Showing classes for animals registered in Sections A, B, C or D of the WPCS Stud Book must be judged in accordance with the breed description contained within the Stud Book. Judges are empowered to judge according to personal preference.

THE WELSH MOUNTAIN PONY

Section A of the Stud Book

Not exceeding 121.9 cm (12.0 hands)

General Character: Hardy, spirited and pony-like

Colour: Any colour, except piebald and skewbald

Head: Small, clean-cut, well set on and tapering to the muzzle

Eyes: Bold

Ears: Well placed, small and pointed, well up on the head, proportionately close

Nostrils: Prominent and open

Jaws and Throat: Clean and finely-cut, with ample room at the angle of the jaw

Neck: Lengthy, well carried and moderately lean in the case of mares, but inclined to be cresty in the case of mature stallions

Shoulders: Long and sloping well back. Withers moderately fine, but not "knifey". The humerus upright so that the foreleg is not set in under the body.

Forelegs: Set square and true, and not tied in at the elbows. Long, strong forearm, well developed knee, short flat bone below knee, pasterns of proportionate slope and length, feet well-shaped and round, hoofs dense.

Back and Loins: Muscular, strong and well coupled
Girth Deep Ribs Well sprung

Hind Quarters: Lengthy and fine. Not ragged or goose-rumped. Tail well set on and carried gaily.

Hind Legs: Hocks to be large, flat and clean with points prominent, to turn neither inwards nor outwards. The hind legs not to be too bent. The hock not to be set behind a line from the point of the quarter to the fetlock joint. Pasterns of proportionate slope and length. Feet well-shaped, hoofs dense.

Action: Quick, free and straight from the shoulder and hocks well flexed with straight and powerful leverage and well under the body.

THE WELSH PONY

Section B of the Stud Book

Not exceeding 137.2 cm (13.2 hands)

The general description of ponies in Section "A" of the Stud Book is applicable to those in Section "B", but more particularly the Section "B" pony shall be described as a riding pony, with quality, riding action, adequate bone and substance, hardiness and constitution and with pony character.

THE WELSH PONY OF COB TYPE

Section C of the Stud Book

Not exceeding 137.2 cm (13.2 hands)

Their true worth as a dual-purpose animal has been fully realised in recent years, and their numbers have increased accordingly. Active, surefooted and hardy, they are ideal for so many purposes both for adults and children. Like all the Welsh Breeds they are natural jumpers and they also excel in harness — there are in fact few things that they cannot be used for.

THE WELSH COB

Section D of the Stud Book

The height should exceed 13.2 hh (137 cms): no upper limit.

Aptly described as "the best ride and drive animal in the World", the Welsh Cob has been evolved throughout many centuries for his courage, tractability and powers of endurance. The general character is the embodiment of strength, hardiness and agility. The head shows great quality with Pony character: bold prominent eyes, a broad forehead and neat, well set ears. The body must be deep, on strong limbs with good "hard wearing" joints and an abundance of flat bone. Action must be straight, free and forceful, the knees should be bent and then the whole foreleg extended from the shoulders as far as possible in all paces, with the hocks well flexed, producing powerful leverage. The Welsh Cob is a good hunter and a most competent performer in all competitive sports. In recent years they have had great success in the international driving world. Their abilities in all spheres are now fully recognised throughout the world.

Detailed Description of Sections C and D

General Character: Strong, hardy and active, with pony character and as much substance as possible

Colour: Any colour, except piebald and skewbald

Head: Full of quality and pony character. A coarse head and Roman nose are most objectionable

Eyes: Bold, prominent and set widely apart

Ears: Neat and well set

Neck: Lengthy and well carried. Moderately lean in the case of mares, but inclined to be cresty in the case of mature stallions

Shoulders: Strong but well laid back

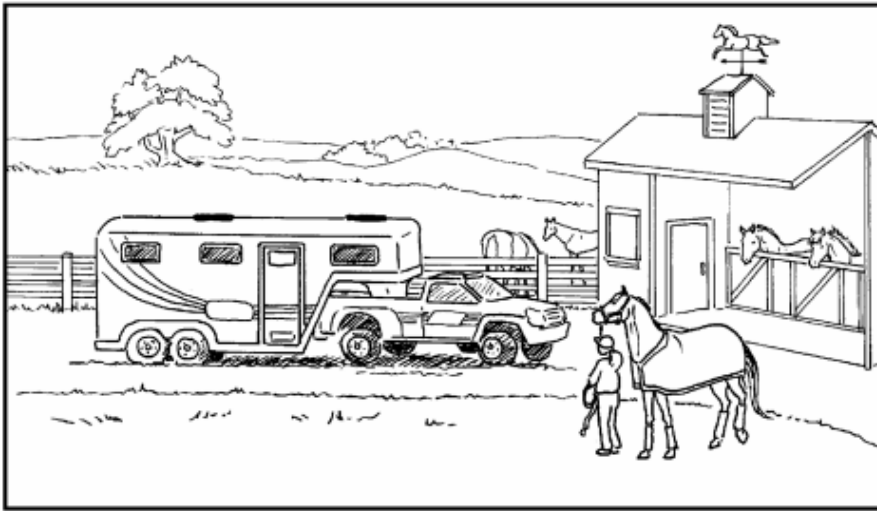
Forelegs: Set square and not tied in at the elbows. Long, strong forearms. Knees well developed with an abundance of bone below them. Pasterns of proportionate slope and length. Feet well-shaped. Hoofs dense. When in the rough, a moderate quantity of silky feather is not objected to, but coarse, wiry hair is a definite objection.

Middle piece: Back and loins, muscular, strong and well-coupled. Deep through the heart and well-ribbed up.

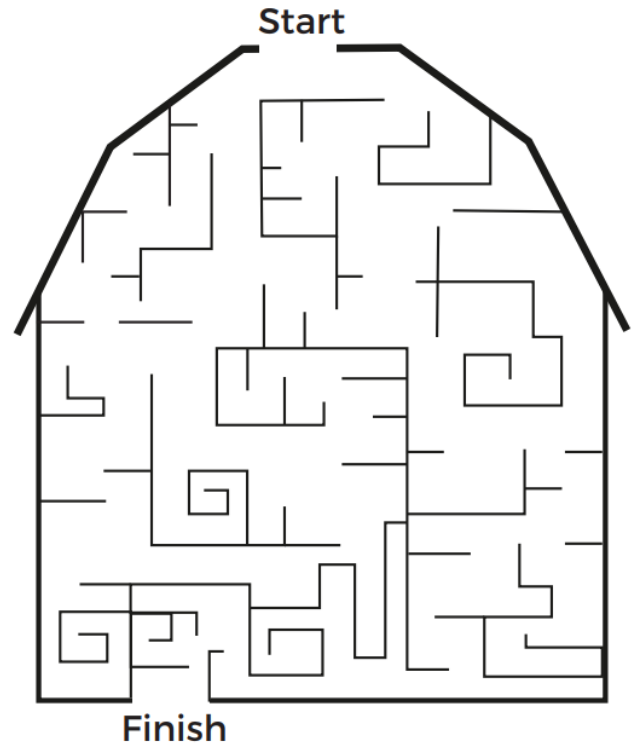
Hind Quarters: Lengthy and strong. Ragged or drooping quarters are objectionable. Tail well-set on.

Hind Legs: Second thighs, strong and muscular. Hocks, large, flat and clean, with points prominent, turning neither inward nor outwards. The hind legs must not be too bent, and the hock not set behind a line falling from the point of the quarter to the fetlock joint. Pasterns of proportionate slope and length. Feet well-shaped. Hoofs dense.

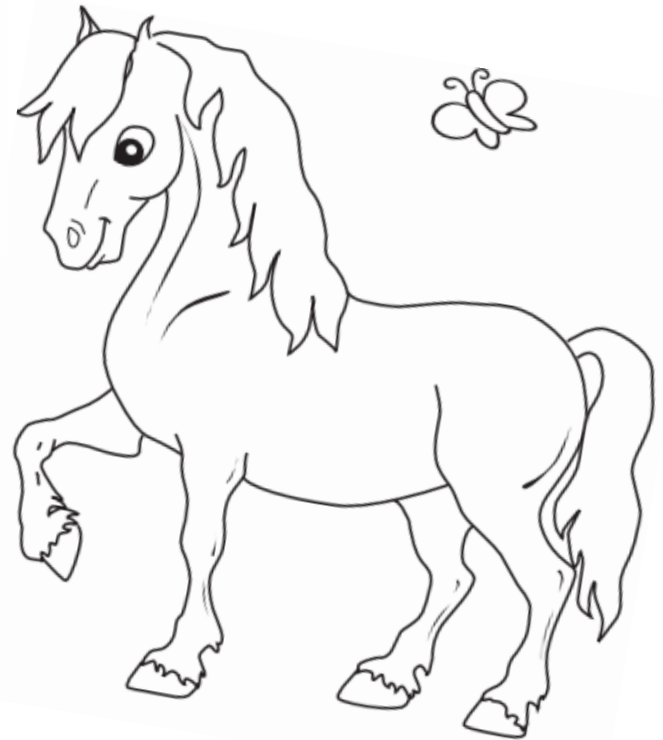
Action: Free, true and forcible. The knee should be bent and the whole foreleg should be extended straight from the shoulder and as far forward as possible in the trot. Hocks flexed under the body with straight and powerful leverage.
