Royal Winter Fair Annual Aisle Party

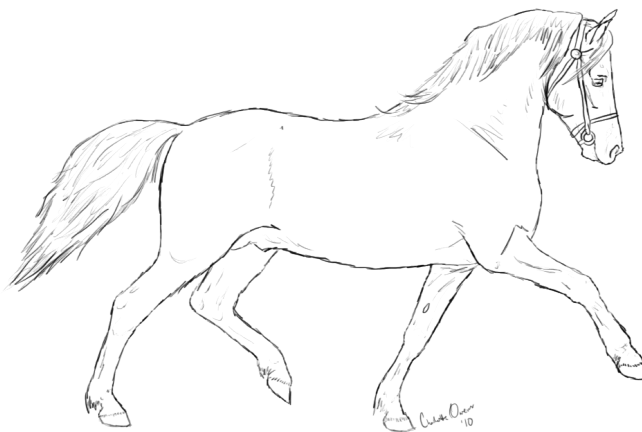

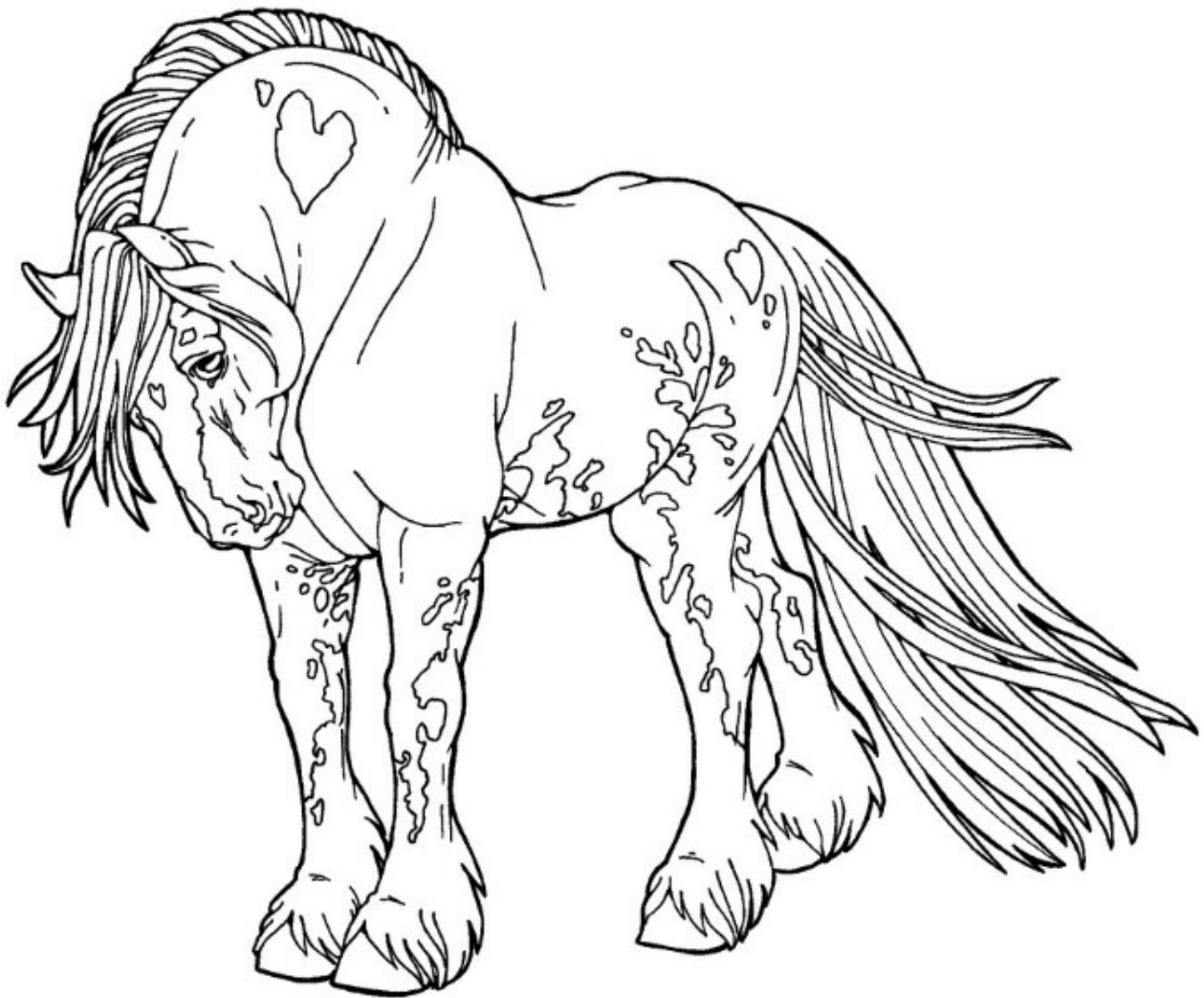

Royal Winter Fair

1. RAWF AGM & Letter from Royal – Pete Dagenias

Letter from the Royal Horse Show Chairman regarding the lack of exhibitors from across Canada and the US in the Welsh Pony & Cob classes at the Royal Winter Fair

- Wild Rose show in Alberta sent a request to the Royal asking for qualifiers for their show for both sport pony and the welsh pony/cob classes
- Chair and CEO of the Royal wants there to Champion of Champions Qualifiers in other provinces and the US

Royal has indicated that they will open up their own wild card for Champion of Champions if the WPCAO does not open up the competition to outside of the Province and the US.

WPCAO will need to ship ribbons to the three different place.

Shirley moved that we add a Champion of Champions qualifiers to NEWPA, the Wild Rose Show and the Quebec show, seconded by Maisie. All in favor. Carried.

Janet moved that we simplify the wording of the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair qualifications to accommodate the Royal's criteria, seconded by Maisie. All in favor. Carried.

Under Saddle – Out of Province/Country

- The WPCAO will advise that the wild card spots (2 per class) should be a first place or second place if the first is unable to attend

Discussion on how to break the ties in the points for under saddle, if ties come up.

In the event of a tie, the first tie breaker would be ribbon placings; the tie goes to pony with the highest ribbon placing.

If the ribbon values are the same, the second tie breaker will be based on ponies bested in the class in which they had their highest ribbon placing.

For example, two ponies with the same number of points both have a second place ribbon. One pony was 2nd out of 6 and another was 2nd out of 4. The pony that was 2nd out of 6 would get the tie.
